Job Summary:

The Dean of Science is responsible for the provision of high-quality educational leadership and the development, implementation and review of educational initiatives that are aligned with the faculty's and the University's strategic priorities, plans, policies, profiles and goals.

To support, reform and renew educational activities to ensure outstanding learning outcomes for students and the development of an environment that promotes improvement in educational performance. The Dean of Science will play a lead role in managing the course and unit profile of the faculty, of monitoring educational outcomes, and will participate in a number of key education committees within both the faculty and the University.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To work with undergraduate students to build and develop student engagement and the student experience.
- To ensure that appropriate strategies and policies are in place to enable the Faculty to promote critical intellectual enquiry and independent academically-rigorous learning in a supportive educational environment for undergraduates.
- To ensure that mechanisms are in place within the Faculty to implement University-wide strategies and policies for learning teaching and the student experience.
- To have managerial responsibility for cross-Department and cross-Faculty undergraduate programmes, where appropriate.
- To ensure that mechanisms are in place to implement, within the Faculty, University-wide strategies and policies for Learning and Teaching and Widening Participation.
- To systematically analyse recruitment, admission and retention information for undergraduate students in the context of national trends and any Faculty-specific educational objectives.
- To promote innovation in learning and teaching, including the oversight of e-education initiatives within the Faculty.
- To take action to achieve the objectives of the Innovation and Enterprise Strategy as appropriate to the role.
- To ensure that undergraduate learning and teaching activities of the Faculty are undertaken in accordance with the governance, policy and regulatory frameworks of the University.
- Performs other duties as assigned
